All manuscripts must be typed in Microsoft Word, not converted from any other software. The font of both the text and the footnotes should be 11 pt., Century Schoolbook, and double-spaced on $8\frac{1}{2} \ge 11$ inch paper. Footnotes should appear at the bottom of each page of text. Text and footnotes should conform to *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation* (19th ed. 2010). Article submissions should be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 300 words.
