Petrs, four of the eight owners of the Trans-Alaska
Pipeline System, seek this Court's review of the CA 5's
dismissal of their petitions for review of an ICC order which
suspended for seven months their proposed rates for transporting
oil through the pipeline and specified lower interim rates that
it would approve. Because the Court is already thoroughly
familiar with the facts and contentions of this case, having
granted petitioners' applications for stay of the ICC order, and
because Mark Richman has previously written two memos setting
forth all the relevant facts and arguments (see memos of
September 26 and October 6), I think that it will suffice for
me just to summarize the issues being raised:

- (1) Whether the ICC has authority under section 15(7) of the Interstate Commerce Act to suspend the operation of an original tariff schedule of a pipeline;
- (2) Whether the ICC may "suggest" interim rates that it will accept during the suspension period without conducting a full hearing; and
- (3) Whether the ICC may impose special refund and accounting obligations with respect to collections made pursuant to original or interim tariffs.

The SG, the State of Alaska, and the Artic Slope Regional Corporation oppose the granting of cert.

There are responses, as well as a reply brief filed by Exxon.
