It is ADJUDGED and ORDERED that plaintiff recover compensatory damages as a recompense for injury actually suffered as a result of plaintiff's arrest, legal expense, insult, mental suffering and injury to his reputation in the amount of \$1250.00, and

It is ADJUDGED and ORDERED that plaintiff be and hereby is denied punitive or exemplary damages; the Court being of the opinion that plaintiff failed to show that defendant acted with actual malice, in the sense of personal ill will or a reckless and wanton disregard of plaintiff's rights,

Judgment is accordingly entered for the plaintiff herein against the defendant herein in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$1250.00) and costs.




UPON CONSIDERATION of the motion and the argument of counsel, it is hereby ORDERED that the motion be denied.

JUDGMENT


THIS CAUSE came on to be heard the 18th day of October, 1978, and, there-
